TIP OF THE MONTH

Summer Wrench: Heat, Highway Miles & Keeping Cool

After months of potholes and drizzle, summer feels like reward season for your car - but the heat, long drives, and sudden UK "mini heatwaves" can expose weak spots fast. A little prep now keeps things smooth when the temperature (briefly) remembers it can rise.

1. Cooling System: Don't Trust the Gauge Alone

Your engine's cooling system does the heavy lifting in summer.

- Check coolant level and condition (not just the expansion tank level - make sure it's properly mixed).
- Look for leaks around hoses and radiator connections.
- If your temperature gauge creeps higher in traffic, don't ignore it - UK traffic jams + hot weather = stress test for any cooling system.

2. Tyres: Heat Changes Everything

Hot tarmac increases tyre pressure and wear.

- Check pressures regularly - especially before motorway runs.
- Inspect for cracks or uneven wear after winter potholes.
- Long motorway journeys expose balancing issues you didn't notice at 30mph.

3. Air Conditioning Reality Check

If your AC is more "gentle breeze" than "cold blast," now's the time.

- Run it regularly to keep the system healthy.
- If it's weak, a re-gas service might be needed.
- Also check cabin filters - a clogged one makes even good AC feel useless.

4. Heat Protection Basics

- Park in shade when possible (yes, even in the UK - we do get sun occasionally).
- Use a windshield sunshade to reduce cabin heat build-up.
- Don't leave electronics or aerosols in the car - heat turns them unpredictable fast.

5. Summer Clean & Protect

- Wash off spring pollen - it's surprisingly corrosive over time.
- Apply wax or sealant to protect paint from UV and bug splatter.
- Clean wheels properly - brake dust bakes on harder in hot weather.

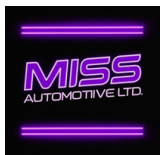
