
Welcome to the second edition of Ride3 Cars newsletter - Miles & Members!



TIP OF THE MONTH

The Winter Survival Kit For You and Your Car

Winter driving isn't just about surviving icy roads - it's about being ready for the curveballs the cold likes to throw. Whether you're cruising to a meet-up or tackling a frosty morning commute, here's what every car enthusiast should stash for the season:

1. Emergency Must-Haves

- *Jumper cables or a portable jump starter: Cold kills weak batteries faster than you can say "click." A portable jump pack is your best friend when there's no one else around.*
- *Tyre inflator & pressure gauge: Tyre pressure can drop 1-2 PSI for every 10°C of temperature drop. Underinflated tyres = bad grip on slick roads.*
- *Tow strap or recovery rope: Because sometimes a little snowbank enthusiasm goes too far.*

2. Comfort & Safety Gear

- *Thermal blanket or spare jacket: Cars lose heat quickly when stalled — stay warm until help arrives.*
- *Gloves and a flashlight: Changing a tyre in the dark with freezing hands is a rite of passage you can skip.*
- *Non-perishable snacks & bottled water: Long delays happen — especially when everyone's spinning their wheels (literally).*

3. Frost-Fighting Tools

- *Windshield scraper and small brush: Ditch the credit card; it's not built for ice warfare.*
- *De-icer spray: Works wonders on frozen locks and wipers. Keep one in your glove box and one at home — not in the frozen boot!*
- *Silicone spray or rubber conditioner: A quick swipe on door seals prevents the classic "door frozen shut" struggle.*

And of course, keep at least half a tank of fuel during winter — it prevents fuel line freeze and gives you peace of mind if you get stranded.

So, pack your winter kit now and you'll thank yourself when the next snowstorm hits — while everyone else is Googling "how to defrost a car with a hair dryer."




